## The Latest on Cohen Veterans Network *(May 5, 2020)*

### **State of Veterans Mental Health in America**

Data from the [America's Mental Health COVID-19](#) Survey suggests veterans and active-duty (four in ten) were **very concerned about their mental health**, almost double the number of non-veterans. Other findings from the survey of 2,000 Americans:

- While 14% of the general population sought mental health care during COVID-19, 50% + sought mental health care in the military-connected community.
- Veterans who served after 9/11 are much more aware of the different telehealth mental healthcare services available to them and nearly 5x as likely to have used them compared to non-veterans.
- Nearly seven in ten veterans who served after 9/11 say they are concerned about their mental health because of social distancing and 6 in ten said they were concerned about their employment status.

### **Current results across the network**

- Cohen Clinics have treated **more than 16,500 clients** across the country from April 2016 to date.
- For the week ending May 1, the Cohen Clinics delivered 1,714 clinical sessions via [CVN Telehealth](#).
- The network is treating the **entire military family - 50% of our clients are non-veterans**. We are treating parents, siblings, spouses or partners, children, caretakers, and others.
- Among all clients, **women represent 50% of the population**. Among just veteran clients, **women make up 24%** of the group. This percentage is two times the size of the female veteran population in the United States.
