Clinics without walls

Nearly all care being delivered has been online via [CVN Telehealth](#), face-to-face video therapy.

- Telehealth sessions for the week ending June 5: **1691, which is 97% of all care.**
- Since March 1, Cohen Clinics have conducted **over 17,100 telehealth sessions.**

Current results across the network

- Cohen Clinics have treated **more than 17,000 clients** across the country from April 2016 to date.
- The network is treating the **entire military family: 50% of our clients are non-veterans.** We are treating parents, siblings, spouses or partners, children, caretakers, and others.
- Among all clients, **women represent 50% of the population.** Among just veteran clients, **women make up 24%** of the group. This percentage is two times the size of the female veteran population in the United States.

State of America's Mental Health

Our [latest survey data](#) indicates:

- While 14% of the general population sought mental health care during COVID-19, 50% + sought mental health care in the military-connected community.
- Four in ten veterans said they were very concerned about their mental health, almost double the number of non-veterans.
